Needs: For the City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a Consultant Services Agreement with

Insite Associates.

Facts:

1. The City Council adopted a Capital Improvement Project in which one of the projects is for

the City to install a new water tank to improve the City's Water Distribution System.

2. The City Council, on November 17, 1999, concluded that the location of the new tank

would be next to the existing tank at Rolling Hills Road.

3. Due to the high visibility of the new tank, it is apparent that the aesthetic design of the new

tank is a critical part of the project.

Conclusion: Staff has received the attached proposal from Insite Associates to investigate and perform 3-4

alternative designs to screen the proposed water tank.

Alternative designs will be presented to the City Council for their review and to select the preferred

alternatives for final design and construction.

A. SCOPE OF WORK

Preliminary Analysis and Design

- Meet with the City staff to review project constraints and objectives.
- Develop 3-4 alternate design concepts. Exhibits shall include: site
 plan / grading plan, exterior elevations, cross sections, photorealistic
 images showing actual site views, and sufficient detail to clarify the
 design concept.
- Meet with City staff to discuss alternatives, and to present alternatives at public hearings. Assume presentation at 3 Planning Commission meetings and 2 City Council meetings.

2 Cost Estimates

 We will prepare a preliminary estimate of costs for each alternate which will give a reasonably accurate range of expected construction costs.

B. FEES

- 1. Fees are based on the assumption that you will provide information pertinent to existing topography, boundaries, and soils conditions on the site.
- 2. These fees include all items above as well as any communication with the City in order to clarify questions regarding the documents, Fees are based on time estimates for the above work, extended using billing rates outlined in our compensation schedule.
- 3. Fees would include progress prints for your review. Additional prints or copies, would be billed to you at cost.
- 4. Once the final design has been approved, the scope of the construction documents and the resultant fee could then be determined and a proposal would be prepared for your consideration.
