Facts:
1. The Planning Commission at their meeting on February 9, 1999 recommended approval of the abandonment request.

- 2. The project site is located west of Locust Street, and north of 18th Street.
- 3. The applicant is requesting that a 40-foot unimproved "paper" street and a 30-foot unimproved "paper" alley be abandoned.
- 4. The abandonment request was submitted by Nancy J. Stinchfield Family Trust, Daryl L. Stinchfield, Trustee. The purpose of their request is to provide the applicant the opportunity to more fully develop their property at Assessor Parcels Nos. 008-271-016-018.
- 5. The property owner who owns the property at A.P.N. 008-271-012 and 013, Ms. Florence Joyce, concurs with the proposed street abandonment and has provided a letter of support.
- 6. The City Council, at their meeting on April 6, 1999 adopted "Resolution of Intent to Abandon" No. 99-56 which set a public hearing to abandon these properties.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the alley and road abandonment herein before described be vacated for public purposes.


