Facts:

Needs: For the City Council to hold a public hearing and consider a request for a street name change.

The proposed name change is from Somers Lane and Dayton Lane to Stonebrook Circle. The subject location is a looped street in Tract 1895-1 which is north of Experimental Station Road, west of Buena Vista Drive and adjacent to Dallons Drive. Please see the location map attached to the draft Resolution.

- 2. The request has been received from Mr. Dick Willhoit, Estrella Associates, per the attached letter (attachment 4).
- 3. Per Section 22.20.085 of the Municipal Code:

"Street name changes shall be accomplished by resolution, following the procedure for such changes as set forth in Section 5026 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, provided, that prior to any street name change the city planning commission shall give notice and conduct a public hearing. The planning commission shall submit a report and recommendation to the City Council for consideration."

- 4. The City's Emergency Services Department and the County Planning Department's Street Naming Section have reviewed the proposed name for duplication and similar sounding names. No street name conflicts were identified with the proposed street name Stonebrook. However, Emergency Services noted that the applicant's request to have a Stonebrook Lane East and Stonebrook Lane West would not be acceptable due to similar sounding names. Emergency Services recommended that the street name be changed to Stonebrook Circle. The applicant's representative, Mr. Dick Willhoit, per phone coordination on May 6, 1999, concurs with the Emergency Services staff recommendation to change the street name to Stonebrook Circle. Street numbering will be changed to meet current procedures for a circle.
- 5. The Planning Commission was scheduled to consider this application at their meeting of May 25, 1999. A verbal report will be presented at the Council meeting on June 1, 1999, summarizing the Commission's action(s).



#### THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize the name change of Somers Lane and Dayton Lane to Stonebrook Circle.

I would like to thank you for the opportunity to review the various issues we have pending on the Specific Plan/General Plan amendment process for Sub-area B within the Borkey Specific Plan.

As you are aware one of the components that I am addressing is the creation of a thematic concept to provide continuity in the development of each neighborhood within this master plan. A component of this themeing will be the identification of neighborhoods and street names that support neighborhood identification. It was my intent to identify all street names, including changes of existing names, as a part of the Specific Plan/General Plan process, which should conclude later this summer. However it has been brought to my attention that in regard to the street names currently established as part of the recordation of Tract Map 1895-1 it would be more expeditious to process that name change independently at this time.

Tract 1895-1, Lots 1-48 will be identified as the Stonebrook neighborhood within the River Oaks Master Planned Community (Stonebrook at River Oaks). Therefore I am requesting a change in street name from the current Somers Lane and Dayton Lane to Stonebrook Lane East and Stonebrook Lane West. As this is a looped street the new name not only provides for less confusion it also supports the neighborhood theme within the overall theme of River Oaks and it also supports the current street address scheme.
