Needs: For the City Council to consider granting a thirty (30) day time extension to the Arciero Development

Company to complete improvements to Prospect Avenue.

Facts: 1. Prospect Avenue was to be completed by June 30, 1999, as requested by the City Council.

2. The developer has requested a thirty (30) day extension to complete the improvements to Prospect Avenue due to utility problems that have been encountered

Analysis and

Conclusion: Arciero Development Company has an obligation to pave Prospect Avenue with the development of

Tract 2223-1. The developer was not able to complete the paving of Prospect Avenue within the one year time granted by the subdivision agreement. This time period expired at the end of January 1999. The City Council granted additional time (to June 30, 1999) to complete Prospect Avenue improvements. A number of residents fronting Prospect Avenue wanted the street to be completed at

an earlier date.

The developer states he has encountered problems with underground utility installation, and therefore, needs more time to complete the roadway. Staff has been informed that the phone lines were installed at the incorrect depth and have to be lowered, thus delaying the preparation of the roadway.
