Needs:

For the City Council to consider a request to close down Experimental Station Road.

Facts:

- 1. As part of the development of Tract 1895, the applicant, Estrella Associates, will be installing sewer mains and road improvements in Experimental Station Road.
- In order to install these facilities, the applicant is requesting that Experimental Station Road between Buena Vista and River Road be closed to through traffic for approximately 1 to 2 months.
- The applicant is proposing to detour traffic to Dallons Drive, a portion of which is paved and the rest is a based, gravel roadway.

Analysis and

Conclusion:

The City Council makes the final approval for street closures for an extended amount of time.

Several residents and one business owner could be affected with this road closure.

It is recommended that as a Condition of Approval for this street closure, the applicant be required to hand deliver notice to the residents/business owner in the area of the upcoming street closure, with advanced notice.

 - 2. Road Closure is allowed for a maximum of two (2) months. Any additional time extensions may be granted by the City Council.
