Needs: For the City Council to consider a request to remove an oak tree.

1. The City has received a request from Peter Winslow to remove an 8-inch diameter oak tree located on Lot 27 of Tract 1771.

2. Mr. Winslow has purchased this lot from Coker Ellsworth.

3. Attached are exhibits showing the location of the tree within the lot. A photograph of the tree is also enclosed.

4. The applicant states that the oak tree needs to be removed so that he can meet the City's front yard setback requirement.

Analysis and

Facts:

Conclusion: Lot layout for Tract 1771 was approved by the Planning Commission to insure that oak trees would be protected/preserved during the construction of the houses.

It is recommended that the applicant work with an architect to design a house plan to preserve the oak tree. For instance, a side loading garage could be utilized, which would reduce the front yard setback requirement.




