



- DATE: DECEMBER 21, 1999
- Needs: For the City Council to consider approving a street section for a portion of Rolling Hills Road as part of the development of Tentative Tract 2350 (Weyrich Development).
- Facts:
- 1. Tentative Tract 2350 is a 175 single-lot residential development behind the Von's Shopping Center between Rolling Hills Road and Golden Hill Road.
- 2. The Tentative Tract Map proposal was approved by the Planning Commission on November 23, 1999.
- 3. The existing configuration for that portion of Rolling Hills Road in front of the Weyrich project is an approximately 24-foot wide asphalt paving with no curbs, gutter or sidewalk.
- 4. In 1977, the existing residential lots west of Rolling Hills Road were annexed into the City, known as the "Arsenio Annexation No. 31". As a condition of the annexation, these property owners requested that the City Council waive the requirements to install curb, gutter, sidewalk and any additional paving along their property.
- 5. Weyrich Development is requesting that they be allowed to improve their side of Rolling Hills Road without the standard concrete curb and gutter and that a meandering sidewalk be installed in lieu of a standard linear sidewalk parallel to the roadway (see attached exhibit).

Analysis and Conclusion:	Road v	the current City Council reverses the decision made in 1977, the west side of Rolling Hills will never be improved as a local street standard. Therefore, it would seem to make sense to he applicant's request.
