<u>Need</u> :	For the City Council to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the submission of an application for Used Oil Block Grant - Sixth Cycle.				
Facts:	 The Council previously adopted Resolution No. 97-33 authorizing the submission of a grant application for the previous cycle with the California Integrated Waste Management Board. The prior grant provided annual funding for three years. 				
	 The proof grant provided annual functing for three years. The City is required to refile a new application every three years (a cycle) to receive funding during the new cycle. 				
	4. If authorized by Council, the grant will provide \$7,800 annually.				
	5. These funds and some of the funds previously received during prior cycles will be used to offset City expenditures for the recently approved used oil recycling program authorized by Council.				

Analysis and

Conclusion:

The California Integrated Waste Management Board provides block grants to public agencies for used oil recycling programs. The City participated in the block grant program during the last cycle of three years and must submit an application and resolution in order to participate in the next cycle.

The Council just authorized the implementation of a used oil recycling program which, after two years, will require that the City incur a new recourring expense of approximately \$7,000 annually. The City will also need to either provide a collection vehicle for the program or convert an existing vehicle for the used oil recycling program. This block grant funding and funds remaining from the prior cycle will be used for these two purposes.

Fiscal Impact:

As noted above, the \$7,800 received annually should be sufficient to cover City's new reocurring expenses associated with the used oil recycling program when its grant funding expires.

Options:

- a. That the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application for the 2000/2003 Used Oil Block Grant funds; or
- b. Amend, modify or reject any of the options above.
