SUBJECT: RESTRICTED TIME PARKING

DATE: JANUARY 21, 2003

Needs: For the City Council to consider authorizing restricted time parking on the west curb of Melody Drive

from Veronica Drive to Niblick Road.

Facts:

1. Melody Dr. is a congested roadway on school mornings from Veronica Dr. to Niblick Rd.

Melody Drive is a residential street with a single lane in each direction, legal curb parking, and it terminates southbound at Niblick Road.

- 3. Residents have complained of long delays in the morning hours due to backed-up traffic on Melody Drive from Niblick Road to Veronica Drive.
- 4. The Streets & Utilities Commission heard this matter at their December 20, 2002 meeting and recommended the matter be brought before the City Council for action.

Analysis & Conclusion:

Melody Drive is a congested roadway from Veronica Drive to Niblick Rd. on school mornings. Melody Drive terminates southbound at Niblick Road and is controlled by a stop sign. Traffic waiting to make a left turn onto Niblick Road must wait for cross traffic. When vehicles are parked against the west curb of Melody Drive, between Veronica Drive and Niblick Road, traffic backs up, as there is only sufficient room for one lane of traffic. Installation of "No Parking" signs, effective Monday through Friday from 0700 am to 0900 am would provide sufficient space allowing vehicles to make a right turn at Niblick Road, while vehicles are waiting to turn left. Residents would only be impacted with restricted parking for a two-hour period on weekdays. The property bordering the area is the side of a residence facing Veronica Drive. (See "Attachment A")

- a. Approve installation of two "NO PARKING, 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM, Monday through Friday" signs on Melody Drive from Veronica Drive to Niblick Road.
