

RESOLUTION NO. 03-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
AMENDING THE CITY'S ADOPTED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

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WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act of 1974, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires every local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles adopted Resolution No. 02-03 on January 3, 2002, adopting amended Conflict of Interest Codes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, as the Code-reviewing body for the City, has determined that the list of designated employees identified in its Conflict of Interest Code in Exhibit "A" of said Resolution No. 02-03 should be amended to include certain new categories of designated personnel required to file a statement of economic interests pursuant to Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 18730;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby amends the City's Conflict of Interest Code as follows:

SECTION 1: Exhibits "A" and "B" to the Code are hereby amended and replaced in their entirety with the revised Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

The City Manager may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this Code. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.

EXHIBIT "B"

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

(Revised February 4, 2003, Resolution No. 03-\_\_\_\_)

**CATEGORY 1**

- (a) *Interests in real property<sup>1</sup> which is located whole or in part (1) within the boundaries of the City of El Paso de Robles, or (2) within two miles of the boundaries of the City of El Paso de Robles, including any leasehold beneficial or ownership interest or option to acquire such interest in real property, if the fair market value of the interest is greater than \$2,000.*
- (b) *Investments<sup>2</sup> in or income<sup>3</sup> from business entities which are contractors or subcontractors which are or have been within the previous two-year period engaged in the performance of building construction or design within the City of El Paso de Robles.*
- (c) *Investments<sup>2</sup> in or income<sup>3</sup> from persons or business entities engaged in the acquisition or disposal of real property within the jurisdiction of the City of El Paso de Robles.*

**CATEGORY 2**

Investments<sup>2</sup> in or income<sup>3</sup> from business entities which manufacture or sell supplies, books, machinery, or equipment of the type utilized by the department for which the designated employee is Manager or Director. Investments include the interests described in Category 1.

**CATEGORY 3**

Investments<sup>2</sup> in or income<sup>3</sup> from business entities which are contractors or subcontractors engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the department for which the designated employee is Manager or Director. Investments include the interests described in Category 1.

<sup>1</sup> *Interests in real property of an individual include a business entity's share of interests in real property of any business entity or trust in which the designated employee or his or here spouse owns, directly, indirectly, or beneficially, a ten percent interest or greater.*

<sup>2</sup> *Investments include:*

- (1) *Any financial interest in or security issued by a business entity, including but not limited to common stock, preferred stock, rights, warrants, options, debt instruments, and any partnership interest or other ownership interest;*
- (2) *A pro rata share of investments of any business entity or trust in which the designated employee or his or her spouse owns, directly, indirectly, or beneficially, a ten percent interest or greater.*

<sup>3</sup> *No source of income is reportable unless the income received by or promised to the public official aggregates \$500 in value during the preceding 12-month reporting period*
