- 3. Per the City Council's request, the Committee identified goals for Council consideration. The following are the four goals chosen:
  - a.) Continue bus stop improvements including red curbs
  - b.) Extend operating hours in a.m. and p.m. for PR CATS and add Saturday service for DAR.

- c.) Provide transportation shuttle service to downtown merchants, employees and customers from off-site locations.
- d.) Make budgetary request for additional shop mechanic for transit vehicles.
