**NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK**

*May 18 – 24, 2003*

***W******HEREAS***, public works services provided in our community are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives; and

***W******HEREAS*** the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs, such as water, sewers, streets and highways, public buildings, and solid waste collection; and

***W******HEREAS***, the health, safety and comfort of this community greatly depends on these facilities and services; and

***W******HEREAS***, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their planning, design and construction is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skills of public works officials; and

***W******HEREAS***, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is materially influenced by the people's attitude and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; and

***N******OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED*** that I, Frank Mecham, Mayor of the City of El Paso de Robles, speaking on behalf of the entire City Council, do hereby declare the Week of May 18 – 24, 2003 as **NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK** in the City of Paso Robles, and call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing our public works and to recognize the contributions which public works officials make every day to our health, safety, comfort, and quality of life.
