HEREAS, some areas of the county are experiencing serious water supply problems and water quality and supply are inextricably linked to the land uses within the watersheds that produce them; and

HEREAS, the city government is the appropriate entity to take the lead in local water policy, resource development, conservation and use, while it is the responsibility of all citizens to conserve and preserve water as a legacy for future generations. It has been demonstrated that the elimination of wasteful water-use practices and improved water-use efficiencies dramatically reduce water usage; and

HEREAS, Water Year 2003 and California's Water Awareness Month offer excellent opportunities to share information on the quality, quantity and importance of one of the Earth's most important resources so we are calling upon each citizen to protect our source waters from pollution, practice water conservation, support water recycling and to get involved in local water issues; and

OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Frank Mecham, Mayor of the City of El Paso de Robles, speaking on behalf of the entire City Council, do hereby declare the Year of 2003 as **INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF FRESHWATER** and May 2003 as **WATER AWARENESS MONTH** and encourage all citizens to become more actively involved in local water issues.
