SUBJECT: Barney Schwartz Park Fee Analysis

DATE: July 1, 2003

Needs: For the City Council to review Barney Schwartz Park user fees.

Facts:

- 1. On February 19, 2002, the City Council adopted a Barney Schwartz Park user fee schedule for sports tournaments, league play (City and independent), facility rentals (including pavilions), and concession operations.
- 2. The Council directed a review of the fee structure after one year's operation.
- 3. Barney Schwartz Park programming (use) began on June 8, 2002. In July 2002, a mechanism for tracking expenses and revenues associated with the maintenance, operation and programming of the Park was established.
- 4. Through April 30, 2003, expenses totaled \$584,884, including \$19,005 for operating capital. The estimated annual cost is projected at \$730,000.
- 5. Through April 30, 2003, revenues generated from special events, tournament play, City sponsored league play and independent league play total \$102,565. The projection through June 30, 2003 is \$115,000.

Analysis & Conclusion:

Conclusion: Allocation of Park costs has been segregated by "active" and "passive" use areas: 16.8 acres is considered "passive", while the remaining 20.6 acres is "active", i.e., used for sporting events and concessions.

Maintenance and operational expenses for typical "passive" park areas are approximately \$10,200 per acre annually. Therefore, the annual cost for the passive portion of BSP is \$171,400. Deducting the passive cost of BSP from the total estimated annual cost of \$730,200 (maintenance and programming) indicates \$558,800 as the annual cost of the active portion for maintenance, operations, programming and tournaments/special events.

Actual sports use detail (BSP Event Data - attached) provides an excellent quantitative tool for distributing the cost of BSP's active areas. Based upon this data, 31% of usage is for independent league play, 50% for City league play, and the remaining 19% is for tournament play and special events. Apportioning the costs against use:

In summary:

It should be noted that the programming expenses include only direct expense, i.e., administration (LRS staff), marketing and other support activities are recorded in generic "adult sports" and "youth sports" budgets, as they are not readily identifiable to individual facilities.

Funds expended over original Park budget estimates were redirected from other existing resources, i.e., total (all) Park maintenance & operations are operating within budget. These resources will not be available next fiscal year.

A citywide fee study will be undertaken this summer, which may serve to sharpen this analysis and provide options for fee adjustments.

Fiscal Impact:

As illustrated above, General Fund support for Barney Schwartz Park is considerable. 18% of the cost for the "active" use portion of Barney Schwartz Park is being recouped from user fees, concession income, and facility rentals. [Independent league play fees are \$6 per game and \$25 per hour for lights. Tournament/special event fees are 10% of gross revenues for youth, and 15% for adult, tournaments. City league fees are \$442 per team per season.]
