SUBJECT: Annual Street Striping
DATE: July 15, 2003

NEEDS: For the City Council to consider awarding a construction contract to perform the City's annual street striping work.

FACTS:

1. The City annually repaints street traffic control markings (striping). The street striping project work is typically performed by a private contractor, selected through the bid process in accordance to the Public Contract Code and the City's Purchasing and Payment Procedures Manual.
2. The City advertised for bids for the Annual Street Striping Project, DPW No. 03-05, publishing notices in a local newspaper and providing specifications to both plan rooms and all requesting individuals. All bids received by the specified deadline were publicly opened at the noticed Bid Opening on June 19, 2003.
3. Five (5) bids were received ranging from a low bid of \$16,441 to a high bid \$47,214.80. The low bid was submitted by Moreno Striping. Attached is a Bid Summary tabulating the bids received. City staff reviewed the bids and concluded the low bid submitted by Moreno Striping is a responsive bid.

CONCLUSION: Council is requested to award a contract to the low responsive bidder for work that is included in the budget, and is needed annually to maintain traffic controls.
