Needs:

For the City Council to consider adopting a "Resolution of Intent" to abandon an unimproved 80-foot wide portion of 12th Street right-of-way between Paso Robles Street and State Highway 101 as shown on the attached exhibit "A".

Facts:

- 1. The Planning Commission at their meeting of August 26, 2003 recommended approval of the abandonment request subject to conditions of approval.
- 2. The abandonment request was submitted by Gregg Wyatt. The purpose of the request is to eliminate the requirement for street improvements on this portion of 12th Street as conditioned by the Planning Commission in their approval of Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 02-001 and to provide parking for his building on Paso Robles Street (Assessor Parcel Number 009-111-005).

Analysis and Conclusion

The request was found to be consistent with the Streets and Highway Code and the City's General Plan. Emergency Services Staff has not raised any concerns regarding the proposed abandonment.

The Streets and Utility Committee has recommended approval.

The Planning Commission recommends approval of the proposed street abandonment subject to revising the conditions of approval of CUP 02-001 to delete improvements to 12th Street and to require the applicant to construct improvements to Paso Robles Street across the frontage of the right-of-way to be abandoned.

The entire 80-foot wide portion of right-of-way proposed for abandonment will be retained as an easement for City sewer and water lines and for other public services.



