**Paso Gathering:** It was moved by Larry Radka, seconded by Byby Root, that we approve expenditures up to \$3,000 for advertising and items to sell [shirts, posters, flyers, etc.] at the Paso Gathering. Passed.

Melody Mullin of the California Wood Carvers changed the dates on the signs and Bob Bryant and Keith Tarwater will put them up on Monday, July 21, at 1:00 p.m.

After the next board meeting we will need help stuffing mailing tubes with posters, flyers, etc.
