SUBJECT: Street Abandonment 03-002 (12th Street, Wyatt)

DATE: October 21, 2003

Needs:

For the City Council to hold a public hearing to consider adopting a Resolution, with conditions, to abandon a portion of 12th Street, an 80-foot wide street, as shown on the attached exhibits.

Facts:

- 1. The portion of 12th Street being considered for abandonment lies between Paso Robles Street and State Highway 101. 12th Street at this location ends at the Caltrans right-of-way allowing no public through traffic.
- 2. The abandonment request was submitted by Gregg Wyatt. The purpose of the request is to accommodate the applicant's desire to eliminate the requirement for street improvements as conditioned by the Planning Commission in their approval of Conditional Use Permit 02-001 and to provide parking for his existing commercial building on Paso Robles Street.
- 3. The Planning Commission at their meeting of August 26, 2003 recommended approval of the abandonment request.
- 4. The City Council, at their meeting on September 16, 2003, adopted "Resolution of Intent to Abandon" No. 03-170 which set a public hearing to abandon this right-of-way.
- 5. Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code §8323, Notice of this Hearing was duly published in the Telegram Tribune, a newspaper published and circulated within the City of El Paso de Robles.
- 6. Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code §8323, two (2) weeks before the date set for this hearing, Notice of Vacation was posted along the line of 12th Street.

Analysis and Conclusion

The request would appear to be consistent with the Streets and Highway Code and the City's General Plan. Emergency Services staff has not raised any concerns regarding the proposed abandonment.

It is recommended that public service easements be retained within the right-ofway proposed to be abandoned. The City will continue maintenance of water and sewer lines in 12th Street. The Streets and Utilities Committee and the Planning Commission have recommended that as a condition of approval the applicant improve the frontage of Paso Robles Street across the abandoned portion of the 12th Street right-of-way.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES VACATING A PORTION OF 12TH STREET, AN 80-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY WEST OF PASO ROBLES STREET (WYATT)

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at their meeting of August 26, 2003, recommended approval of the abandonment request; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Paso Robles, at their meeting of September 16, 2003, adopted a Resolution of Intention to close and vacate a portion of 12th Street, an 80-foot public right-of-way, from Paso Robles Street to State Highway 101 in the City of Paso Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, based on the Staff Report, Staff presentation and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested in the proposed vacation, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds:

- A. That pursuant to Streets and Highways Code §8322 a Notice of this Hearing has been appropriately published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of El Paso de Robles; and
- B. That pursuant to Streets and Highways Code §8323 a Notice of Vacation has been appropriately posted along the line of the street to be vacated; and
- C. That 12th Street from Paso Robles Street to State Highway 101, an eighty (80) foot right of way as described in this Resolution, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EL PASO de ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Subject to the conditions set forth in Sections 2 and 3 below, 12th Street, as herein before described be vacated for public purposes Exhibit "A".
- 2. That the City retains an easement for the construction, operation and maintenance of water, sanitary sewer, and other public utilities and services over and under the right-of-way to be abandoned, as described in Exhibit "A".
- 3. City Conditions Precedent to the Vacation are as follows:
 - a. The applicant shall construct curb, gutter and sidewalk on Paso Robles Street in accordance with City of Paso Robles Standard Drawing A-4 across the frontage of the right-of-way to be abandoned.
- 4. That upon receipt of satisfactory evidence that the conditions reflected in Section 3 above have been completed, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles is authorized to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Clerk Recorder, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
- 5. The above Recitals are incorporated into this Order.





EXHIBIT "A" FOR RESOLUTION OF INTENT
