**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 pm by Vice Chairman Bill Rouch.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

1. Transit Report for the month of April, 2004 was presented. Staff reported that the system is doing well with a fixed box ratio of 19%+. Year to date figures are heading for an all time record in May with only 11 months reporting.
2. Discussion was held regarding the senior's need for pick up service on Posada Lane across from TCCH and the need for red curbing to allow room for turning around. TCSD may be approached to do the painting since it is in their area. Staff suggests that any decision be delayed until the North County Transit Study is completed and concerns are addressed with regard to Route C. The service to Cuesta is not attracting riders and it may be possible to keep the TCCH loop and add the additional stops. The bus also stops at Heather Court across from TCCH.
