SUBJECT: Appointment of Council Ad Hoc Committee – Water Rate Re-Structuring

DATE: February 1, 2005

Needs: For the City Council to appoint an ad hoc committee to consider alternative water rate

structures.

Facts:

- 1. During last summer's water emergency, Council members voiced a desire to look at various water rate structure alternatives.
- 2. Given the lack of good historical consumption data, staff was unable to immediately provide alternate rate structures.
- 3. Over the last six months, sufficient seasonal consumption and billing data has been collected to move forward with developing various options for Council consideration.
- 4. While the alternatives are not yet complete, appointment of an ad hoc committee at this time would be timely and desirable.

Analysis and

Conclusion:

It is desirable that the Council appoint an ad hoc committee to assist in the development of alternative water rate structures.

The current rate structure provides for a base flat rate for 20 units (15,000 gallons of water) for a bi-monthly billing period plus a variable for each unit over 20 units.

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Options:

- a. That the Council appoint a two member ad hoc committee to assist with the development and preparation of alternative water rate structure; and report back to the full Council by July 1, 2005.
- b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.
