Rules & Regulations - No action.

City Liaison - Current City Council action to consider early retirement of the Airport loan to the General Fund.

<u>Airport Master Plan</u> – Final corrected version of the Master Plan is completed and has been reviewed. It is ready for publication. Airport Land Use Plan was adopted by the County Airport Land Use Commission on February 16. Publication of the final draft will take place shortly.

<u>Airport Promotion</u> – Suggestions to further promote local participation on the established Display Day through more involvement of the local users organizations were discussed. Staff reported on web page modifications. A casino flight is scheduled for March 3. An additional fly-in (formation flying clinic) is booked for the April 1 weekend.

<u>Airport Safety</u> – Mr. Weber reports the sub-committee report has been completed. Following staff review, it will be presented to the committee for consideration at the next meeting.

<u>Ultralight Operations</u> – No action. Staff discusses the need to again ask FAA to identify the required procedure, as it now seems all communication from the FAA has stopped.
