SUBJECT: Notice of Intention to Consider Abandoning a Portion of 38th Street

SA 04-006 (Vernon)

DATE: April 5, 2005

Needs:

For the City Council to approve a resolution providing "Notice of Intention" to consider abandoning an unimproved variable width portion of 38th Street right-of-way between Vine Street and Oak Street as shown on the attached exhibit "A".

Facts:

- 1. The abandonment request was submitted by Brad Vernon. The purpose of the request is to expand residential use of the parcels adjacent to the abandoned area.
- 2. The Planning Commission at their meeting of January 25, 2005, in a unanimous decision, recommended denial of the abandonment request.
- 3. 38th Street is a roughly developed gravel road. The existing grade of 38th Street does not conform to City Standards for vertical profiles.
- 4. A City Standard Road could not be built in the existing right-of-way without significant alteration of the existing terrain.

Analysis and Conclusion

The subject request was found to be consistent with the Streets and Highway Code and the City's General Plan. Emergency Services Staff has not raised any concerns regarding the proposed abandonment.

The Planning Commission recommended denial of the proposed street abandonment on a unanimous vote. The Commission determined that 38th Street was useful as a connection between Vine and Oak Streets. The Planning Commission was not presented with detailed information regarding the current condition of 38th Street and the constraints associated with its ultimate development as a City Street.

The existing terrain in the 38th Street right-of-way drops off of the edge of paving on Vine Street at a slope in excess of 20 percent. In accordance with City Standards, a street should slope at no more than 3 percent for the first 20 feet beyond the curb line of an intersecting street; and then no more than 15 percent beyond that point. Substantial alteration of existing grades, including fill in excess of 10 feet in vertical height, would be necessary to bring 38th Street into conformance with City Standards.

Due to the existing condition of 38th Street, it would appear that the City would benefit from the abandonment of the street by the elimination of a safety hazard.

The northerly half of the right-of-way of 38th Street is owned in fee by the City by virtue of a quit claim deed from Caltrans. The abandonment of the street right-of-way provides the City with the opportunity to benefit by the proceeds of transferring the property, should the City choose to do so.


