DATE: MAY 5, 2005

- Needs: For the City Council to consider awarding the contract to install an in-roadway signal system (LED-lighted crosswalk) at the intersection of 24th and Oak Streets.
- Facts:
- 1. The Council has allocated a total of \$70,600 from 2002 and 2003 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to install an in-roadway signal system (LED-lighted crosswalk) at the intersection of 24th and Oak Streets.
 - 2. On December 21, 2004, the City Council directed that the plans and specifications for this project be revised to eliminate concrete strips into which LED lights would be set and that the project be re-bid.
 - 3. On April 13, bids were opened. The City received a single bid, in the amount of \$57,308 from by Lee Wilson Electric of Arroyo Grande. (Lee Wilson's prior bid, with the concrete strips included, was \$74,900.)
 - 4. After paying consultant fees for design of the project and for printing and legal advertising, \$62,300 remains in the project budget.

Analysis and Conclusion:

Lee Wilson Electric's bid is complete, responsive, and responsible.

In addition to revising the plans and specifications to eliminate the concrete strips, City staff took efforts to solicit more bids, and spoke with several contractors who took out plans and indicated a interest in bidding. However, as of the time of the bid opening, only one bid was received.

The first and second set of bid documents requested a lump sum bid; the third set included a schedule of project components. Lee Wilson Electric's bid was divided into the following components:

1.	Mobilization and traffic control (lump sum)
2.	Install PCC handicapped ramp (including demolition of existing
	sidewalk) (one each)\$ 9,575
3.	Install conduit for in-roadway lights and actuators (includes
	sawcutting and coring of AC pavement (410 linear feet @ \$27/lf)\$11,070
4.	Install LED-Lighted in-roadway signals (14 lights @ \$1,314 each) \$18,396
5.	Install poles, lighted signs, push-button actuators (4 @ 2,770 each) \$11,080
6.	Install control cabinet and connect to power grid (one each)\$ 6,687
	Total \$57,308

An adequate amount of CDBG funds has been budgeted to cover the contract costs and for any contingencies that may arise.
