Needs:	For the City Council to consider extending the term of the Transit Service Issues ad hoc committee.
Facts:	1. In October, 2004, City Council established an ad hoc committee to consider a variety of transit service issues. Committee members are Mayor Mecham and Councilman Picanco. The ad hoc committee was scheduled to disband in May, 2005.
	2. Improve Senior Transportation is the #6 adopted City Council Goal for fiscal years 2006 – 2009.
	3. City Council received a request from the Senior Advisory Committee requesting the reinstatement of a Transit Advisory Committee (disbanded in 2004 due to lack of participation).
	4. Extension of the ad hoc committee would allow additional time to meet with senior representatives to discuss their concerns.
Analysis and	
Conclusion:	Improvement of senior transportation is a goal shared by the Senior Advisory Committee and the City Council. A City Council ad hoc committee was appointed to consider transit service issues. Extending the duration of the ad hoc committee will facilitate discussion between the Senior Advisory Committee and City Council. This discussion may include consideration of reinstating the Transit Advisory Committee.
