SUBJECT: Roof Design for Sherwood Forest Playground Structure
DATE: June 21, 2005

NEEDS: For the City Council to consider the final design for the roof over the Sherwood Forest playground structure (Phase 1A).

FACTS:

1. In September 2003, after several community workshops and input from a City-wide task force committee, Parks & Recreation Advisory Committee, REC Inc., and the Planning Commission, the City Council adopted a Master Plan to improve/enhance Oak Creek and Sherwood Park.
2. Contributions from REC Inc. and subsequent grants from the State were available to proceed with Phase I implementation of the Master Plan. This first phase is to relocate, replace and expand the existing playground structures. This phase of the project is also known as "Sherwood Forest" for its thematic approach to the playground environment.
3. In November 2004, one design for the roof over the playground structure was presented to the City Council. City Council directed staff to develop other options.

**ANALYSIS
AND**

CONCLUSION: Three designs were developed and presented to REC Inc., the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, and a City Council Ad Hoc Committee. All selected Option B (stripes) for the final design. This was chosen because it was considered to be the most appropriate for the Sherwood Forest theme. This roof would also provide shade from the sun during the hot summer months.

Tim Maloney, with Community Design Group, will present the final design concept of Phase 1A (Sherwood Forest) at the meeting.

POLICY

REFERENCE: Sherwood Park Master Plan

FISCAL

IMPACT: The City Council recently adopted a budget in the amount of \$588,300 to complete Phase 1A (Sherwood Forest) of the Master Plan.

OPTIONS:

- a. Approve the final design concept as presented and accept the recommendation from REC Inc., the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee, and the City Council Ad Hoc Committee, to install Option B (stripes) roof over the playground structure; and dissolve the Ad Hoc Committee as its work has been completed.
- b. Amend, modify, or reject the above option.

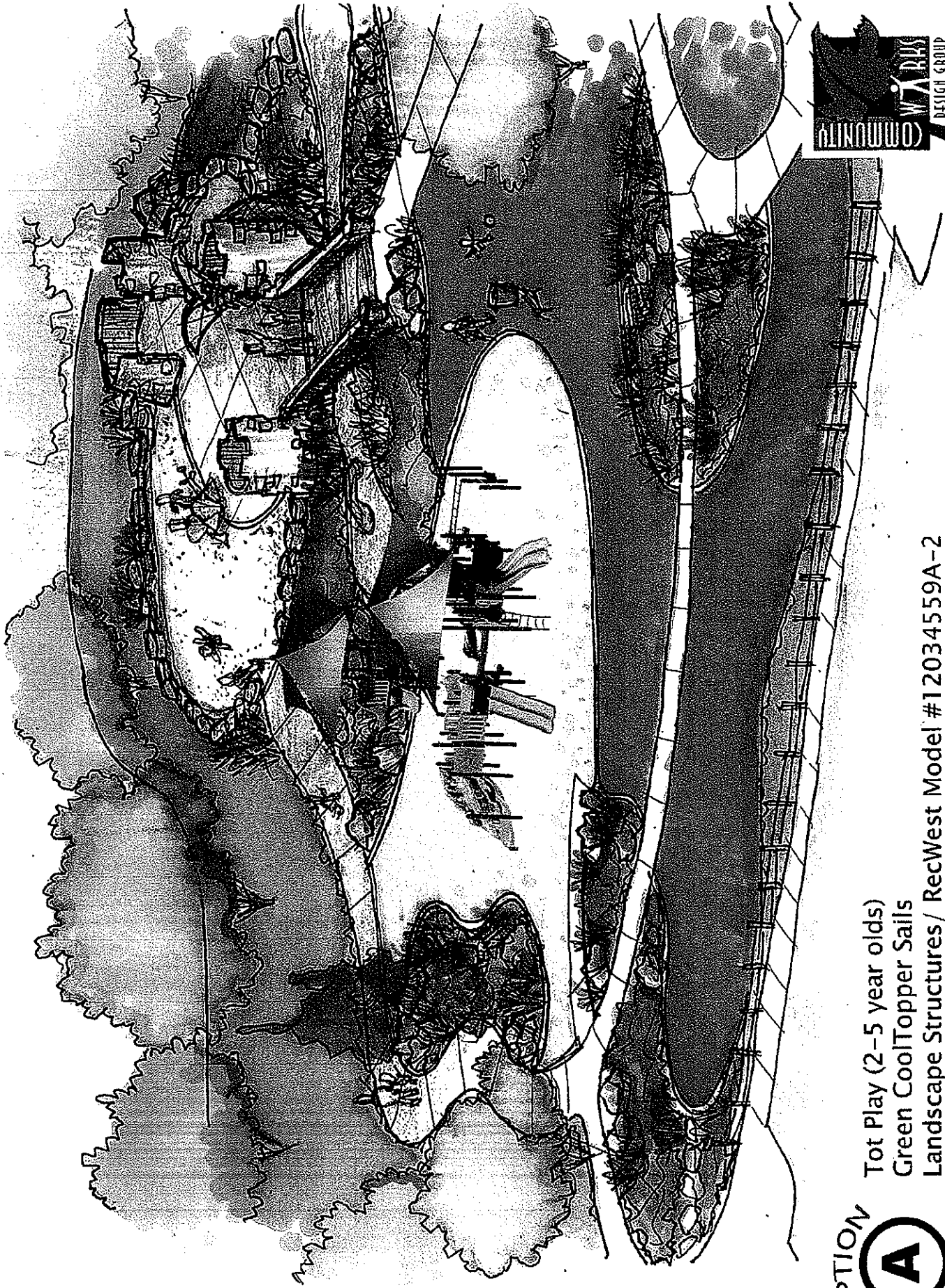

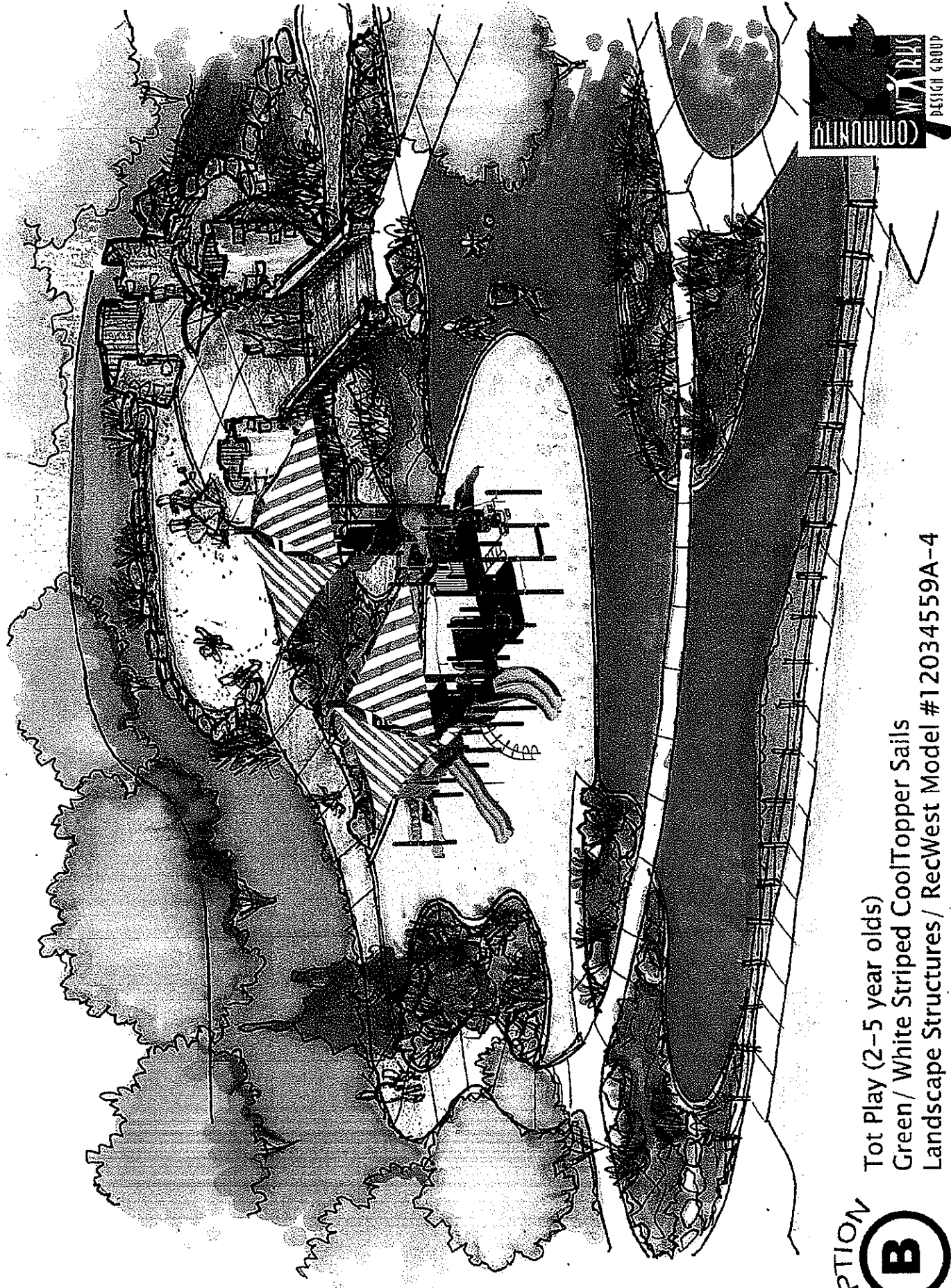

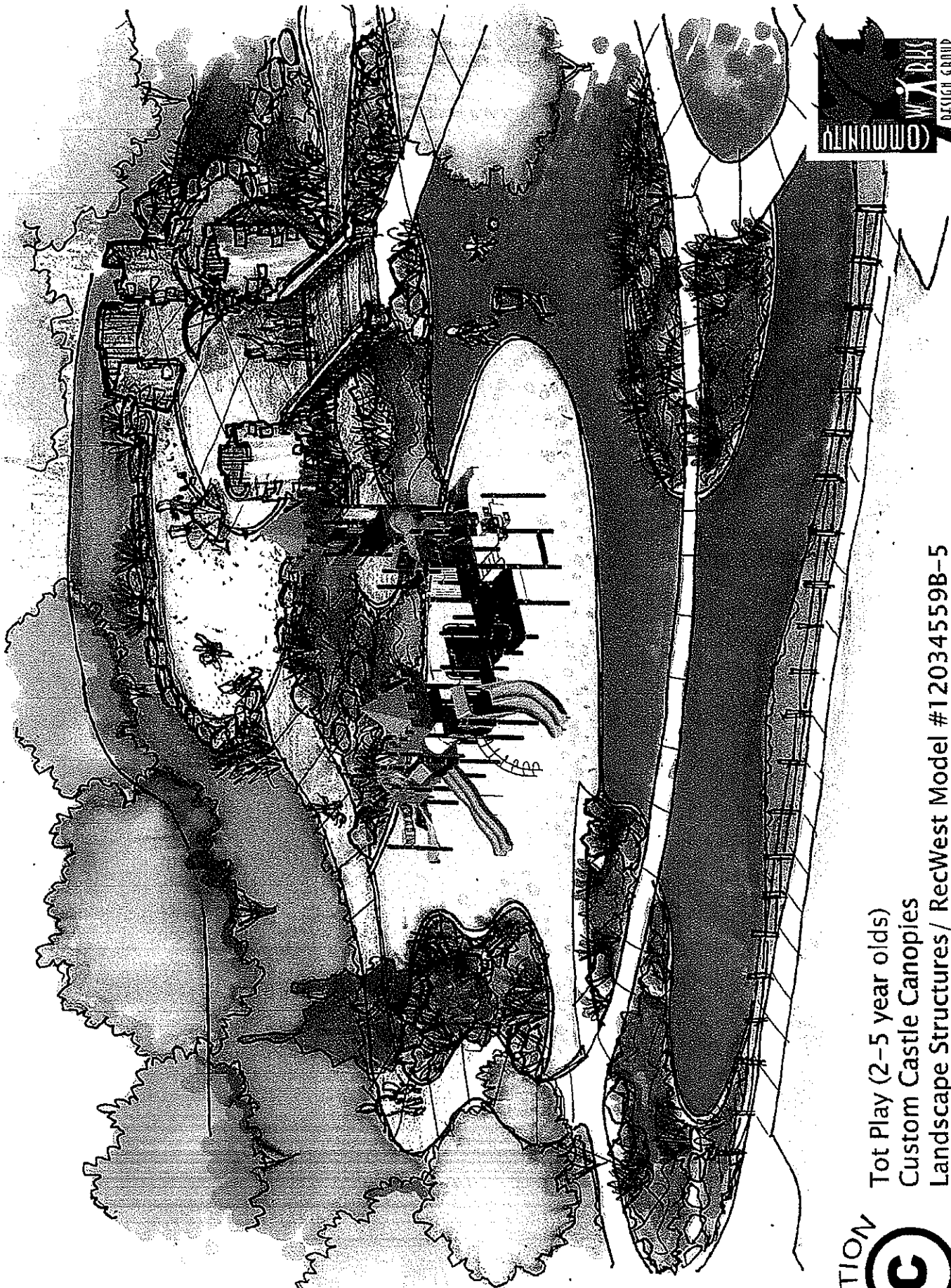
