Needs: That the City Council authorize the acceptance of public improvements resulting from

the development of Tract 2358 into the City's maintenance system.

Facts: 1. On March 23, 2004, the City Planning Commission approved Tract 2358 subject to conditions of approval to construct utilities and street improvements to serve the seven lot subdivision.

- 2. This subdivision is located around a new cul-de-sac, Tranquil Hills Court, which takes access from Rolling Hills Road north of Creston Road (see attached Vicinity Map).
- 3. The public improvements in Tract 2358 have been constructed to the satisfaction of City staff.
- 4. The Subdivider has constructed the following street in Tract 2358 in accordance with the conditions of approval of the Planning Commission and in compliance with the improvement plans and all applicable City standards:



RESOLUTION NO. 05-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES ACCEPTING PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED PURSUANT TO CITY PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL OF TENTATIVE TRACT 2358 (FRANKLIN-PETERSON)

WHEREAS, Tract 2358 was tentatively approved by the City Planning Commission on March 23, 2004 subject to Conditions of Approval; and

WHEREAS, all public improvements required as Conditions of Approval for this subdivision have been constructed in compliance with the improvement plans and all applicable City Standards, and the City Engineer has certified to the Council the completion of such public improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Subdivider has constructed, installed or completed the following streets or roads in accordance with the improvement plans and all applicable City Standards:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Upon completion of all public improvements to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, that the public improvements constructed as required for Tract 2358 be accepted into the City's maintenance system, approximately 0.06 miles in length, and the City shall assume responsibility for their future maintenance and repair. The Subdivider shall be obligated for maintenance of all public improvements for a period of at least one year from date of acceptance by the City Council.
