SUBJECT: Surplus Property Declaration

DATE: October 18, 2005

Needs: For the City Council to adopt a resolution declaring certain City equipment as

surplus and authorizing its disposal in the manner described below.

Facts:

1. The current budget and the adopted equipment replacement program provides resources to replace vehicles, certain heavy equipment and office equipment on a set schedule.

- 2. The age and maintenance/repair costs of the surplus equipment makes it 'cost ineffective" to use the equipment in a different capacity or department.
- 3. To dispose of property scheduled to be replaced, the Council must declare said equipment as surplus.
- 4. The funds generated from the sale of surplus property would be deposited into the Equipment Replacement Fund (except for enterprise equipment which is deposited back into the applicable enterprise fund).

Analysis and Conclusion:

Before the City may dispose of un-needed property, the City must first declare said property as surplus.

The City disposes of surplus vehicles and heavy equipment by public auction while office equipment is first made available to City staff at market value as set by IT staff.

<u>Fiscal</u> <u>Impact</u>:

It is estimated that the sale of surplus property would generate about \$25,000 for the City.

Options:

- **a.** Adopt Resolution No. 05-xx declaring certain City property as surplus and approving the method of disposal as identified therein; or
- **b.** Amend, modify, or reject the above option.

RESOLUTION NO. 05-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS

WHEREAS, the City is purchasing various vehicles and equipment per Council budgetary authorization and replacement schedules; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer has a need or use for the vehicles being replaced; and

WHEREAS, it is highly desirable to sell the surplus equipment for the highest return possible.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the City property identified in the attached Exhibit "A" are declared surplus and are to be sold by public auction except that computer equipment shall be first made available to City staff at fair market value; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the Director of Administrative Services is authorized to undertake any and all actions to transfer title to the successful bidder/purchaser.
