#### **Discussion:**

2. Public Presentation: Airport Watch.

Stan Levanduski, local representative to the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA), presents an overview of a national airport watch program, designed to promote vigilance and awareness among regular airport users, in an effort to increase security and reduce the threat of illegal use of general aviation aircraft. The Committee expressed support for the program. Staff will review implementation alternatives and report back at the next meeting.

- 3. Sub-Committee Reports
  - <u>City Liaison</u> Chuck Miller reports on the Museum's effort to purchase and make available an Automatic Emergency Defibrillator (AED) and to train almost 25 of the museum members in its use.
  - <u>Airport Promotion</u> Meg Williamson reports on the progress of planning for the Business Expo in April 2006, and the cooperative effort with the Chamber of Commerce that is taking shape. The next planning meeting is November 4, 2005, which Mr. Caruthers will attend and help to formulate the airport involvement in the overall effort.
  - <u>Airport Safety & Security</u> The recently completed security report has been received and filed by the City Council. Although there is no immediate work for the sub-committee, it was decided keep the sub-committee intact, in view of upcoming security considerations with the Airport Watch program.

Mr. Rose suggests consideration of the acquisition of additional property on the east side of the Airport for future FBO and aircraft service facilities. This would be enhanced by the possible extension of Aerotech Way, to the north.
