SUBJECT: CDBG-FUNDED IN-ROADWAY SIGNAL SYSTEM: AWARD OF BID
DATE: FEBRUARY 7, 2006

Needs: For the City Council to consider awarding the contract to install a wireless in-roadway signal system (LED-lighted crosswalk) at the intersection of 34th and Spring Streets.

Facts:

1. The Council has allocated a total of \$75,220 from 2004 and 2005 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to install an in-roadway signal system (LED-lighted crosswalk) at the intersection of 34th and Spring Streets.
2. On September 20, 2005, the City Council approved solicitation of bids for a wireless in-roadway signal system.
3. On January 17, bids were opened. The City received three bids. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Chrisp Company of Fremont in the amount of \$34,830. A Bid Summary is attached.
4. After paying for printing and legal advertising, nearly \$40,000 will remain in the project budget.

Analysis and Conclusion: Chrisp Company's bid is complete, responsive, and responsible. The \$34,830 price is within the cost estimate, which was \$35,000. An adequate amount of CDBG funds has been budgeted to cover the contract costs and for any contingencies that may arise. Unused funds may be reprogrammed for other CDBG-eligible projects.

Policy Reference: Federal regulations governing CDBG funds

Fiscal Impact: No impact the General Fund.

WHEREAS, via Resolutions 04-45 and 05-50 the City Council has allocated a total of \$75,220 from 2004 and 2005 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the installation of an in-roadway signal system (also known as an LED-Lighted Crosswalk) at the intersection of Spring and 34th Streets; and

WHEREAS, via Resolutions 04-166 and 05-148, the Council has appropriated a total of \$75,200 in CDBG funds to this project into Budget Account No. 227-910-5452-529; and

WHEREAS, the bid opening for the Project was held on January 17, 2006; three bids were received; the lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Chrisp Company of Fremont for \$34,830.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

1. Awarding the bid for the Project to low bidder Chrisp Company of Fremont in the amount of \$34,830.00.
2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the construction contract.
