COMMITTEE BUSINESS

1. Minutes

A motion by Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Miller to approve the minutes of the August 24 meeting passes unanimously.

2. Sub-Committee Reports

- <u>City Liaison</u> Mr. Miller reports on City Council approval of the recent FAA grant funding for an environmental study for Airport projects.
- <u>Airport Promotion</u> Airport Day was very successful in showcasing and exposing the community to the Airport and the many aspects of aviation. Attendance numbers were up from last year.
- <u>Airport Safety & Security</u> Staff has had follow-up meetings with the Police Dept. to discuss enhanced training of PD personnel, work to initiate a "Business Watch" program among Airport tenants, and update computer files to make airport information more readily available to Police personnel.

DIRECTOR/MANAGER BUSINESS

3. Development Status Report

Staff reviewed the monthly Development Status Report which includes each development or construction project in the vicinity of the airport. The POS (Parks & Open Space) zoning designation continues to draw discussion relative to future projects that might be considered within that zone – particularly as it relates to a proposed rezone before the City Council on October 3. The consensus of the Committee was that POS zoning was a compatible zoning designation for the airport based on the Paso Robles Airport Land Use Plan but it was their desire to underscore for the City Council the importance of a high level of project scrutiny to assure that new development in POS would not conflict with adopted land use policies (relative to density of people and/or encouragement of residential). A Motion by Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Miller, to direct Staff to prepare a statement representative of Committee position on the matter for presentation at the City Council meeting on Oct. 3, passes unanimously.

4. Airport Day 2006

Discussed under Sub-committee reports. No further action taken.

5. Fuel Price Survey

Due to technical difficulties, presentation of the survey is deferred to the next meeting.
