Also, there is an internal recruitment for a part-time position, and Julie is working with Personnel on an on-going recruitment program.

Julie reported that the Library Foundation marketing committee has made progress on ideas for a limited run advertising campaign with the help of the 20-20 Design group. She will bring examples to the Board as soon as possible.

<u>Councilman Strong</u> told the Board that the City Council is considering joining a county-wide promotion of our area hotels. There is funding for the river walk but a bike trail needs additional money. PG&E has donated \$25,000 for the Children's Museum. The City is participating with the school district for landscaping around Flamson school, and paramedic training is coming to the north county campus of Cuesta College.

UNSCHEDULED MATTERS

President Surber related that the Black Gold Advisory Board is considering a resolution to be sent to the governor and state representatives urging full funding for the Public Library Fund. Individual library boards and city councils are urged to do the same and President Surber will have more on this topic at the next meeting.
