Needs: That the City Council consider a request to allow placement of a temporary wood

walkway at 1421 Spring Street.

1. John Kelly, contractor for the structural retrofit of the building at 1421 Spring Street, has requested placement of a covered walkway from January 1 to December 1, 2007.

2. Similar installations have been allowed in other areas of the downtown for safety of the public.

Facts:

Conclusion:

The approval of the request for a covered walkway is necessary to protect the public during the seismic retrofit process. The covered walkway will result in the loss of downtown parking and an inconvenience to pedestrians and vehicles. In addition, the City also received numerous complaints regarding aesthetics and lack of maintenance of similar temporary covered walkways.

The walkway provides the property owner the opportunity to efficiently pursue the structural retrofit of the building in accordance with Council direction. There are limited options available to complete the work while keeping the sidewalk open to the public. Painting the wooden structure will amend its appearance. In addition, limiting the period of operation of the temporary walkway from January 1 to December 1 will avoid the loss of parking in the prime holiday shopping season.


