

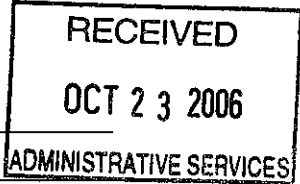



Additional Information

Since we first moved to Paso Robles in 2000, I have been in love with this town and have looked for the best ways in which my specific skills could contribute to improving the life of all of it's residents and to the overall health and well being of the city as a whole. In 2003, that search led me to a very rewarding term serving on the Library Board of Trustees. While I left that Board at the end of my term last summer Fred Strong and others honoured me by expressing their appreciation for the unique and thoughtful contributions I had made. I had felt privileged to be part of such a dynamic group; all of whom I felt gave much more than I to that unique institution.

Part of my unusual skill is the ability to apply both quantitative and qualitative thinking to a problem. I am both a Certified Quality Manager associated with the American Society for Quality (most of whom are engineers) and a strong customer advocate and experienced customer services manager, having served as Director of Customer Focus for QVC Inc., where I was the last stop in the Office of the President where QVC's millions of customers brought their problems or concerns. I also had all the fun of identifying and managing product recalls, being the project manager when strange events such as UPS strikes (think the equivalent of an earthquake for a company such as QVC) at Christmas happened, and explaining to vendors why they couldn't "lie" about their products on television. Not exactly the planning commission, but I mention these things here because I believe that these types of tensions, of communication balance in the face of understandably opposing interests, and of both quantitative and qualitative thinking are what is needed to work effectively in the complex and rapid run world that is now planning in Paso Robles.

As reported in the latest UCSB forecast, we are now expected to surpass San Luis Obispo's population within 15 yrs or less and have grown 19% just in the time since I moved here in 2000. In fact, my 1927 home overlooks one development that was being completed just as we moved in (Villa Verde) and another now near completion (Montebello). I look out every morning on the reality of that growth and then drive out once again the latest Union road detour. (One more year? - by the way, will I ever get a gas line or city water or sewer? Does infill apply to my lot - can I get an R2 zoning? Maybe I should move back to the planned community I lived in in 1988 or to the "living space-over commercial" that was my first home after college in 1980?).

More seriously, when I applied to join the Library Board, I believed I could make a unique contribution there because of my lifelong love affair with books and education, my experience in establishing policy and process, and my sensitivity to customer needs and requirements. In making this application, two of those skills - establishing policy and process, and my sensitivity to customer needs and requirements, are again relevant, but there is more.

As a professional marketing researcher and consultant, I had the opportunity in 2005 to design and implement a research study for the San Luis Obispo Department of Building and Planning, in coordination with Chuck Stephenson and his team. As that work evolved, I became deeply interested in the quandaries that surrounded each difficult planning decision and what those decisions meant for individuals and whole communities and for both shorter and longer term economic outcomes. I was also struck by how enmeshed those in the planning world were in their own reality and how that reality, even to the language that was a part of it, was foreign to most "common" residents, unable to spend every Tuesday night at a Council or other civic meeting. Ultimately, I attended three of the four regional 2050 meetings held last fall (surprised and delighted to see all of our survey results flying across the large projection screens!) as well as meetings sponsored by self-help housing and other groups. I also ran into new learning about housing, commercial, and planning issues in working on research to support proposals for Prop 63 re: housing issues for the mentally ill and the underemployed and in work with Loaves and Fishes on their longer term strategic planning. All in all, I have developed an intense awareness of the complexity and centrality of the entire planning process to our city's future and to our place as the eventual largest city in this county. In fact, I am in the process of gathering information about the Masters program in Planning at Cal Poly and considering a career change to move fully into the field.

As a child, I spent happy weekends at my grandparents. My grandfather and his had been nurserymen, growing what we referred to as "rows of little trees." Part of what I remember from later years is his saying that you never knew until the end of the year if you made any money growing trees or not. In fact, the family made money not by growing trees, but by selling the land and moving the business father and farther out of the center of town every ten years or so as Memphis Tennessee sprawled eastward and northward away from the Mississippi River bluffs. This is not what we want and not what we will ever allow to happen in Paso Robles. I would be honoured to be chosen for the Paso Robles Planning Commission and to be allowed to apply my unique combination of quantitative, planning, people, analysis, listening and creative skills to help us achieve the best possible pattern of growth.
