- The balance as of 4/24/07 was \$294.856.29.
- Lynda Holt, Recreation Coordinator, discussed the Senior Scholarship fund
  established to help senior citizens pay for classes they would like to take offered
  by the Recreation Department. Lynda referred to the Senior Advisory Committee
  December 14, 2004 Minutes establishing the Senior Scholarship account from the
  Senior Endowment Fund. Lynda will work with finance to assign an account
  number to withdrawals for this program.

## 4. Transportation

- Lynda reported on the new bus buddy program funded through a SLOCOG Grant. The Paso Robles Senior Center is one of three sites selected to train seniors in this new program. The first training was in May, and the next training is scheduled for June 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Lynda is working on having transportation information on all available programs available at the Senior Center.
