Update Sewer & Water Development Impact Fees

Needs:

For the City Council to apporint an hoc committee to review the City's sewer and water development impact fees update study.

Facts:

- 1. It is the Council's policy to formally review impact fees every two years.
- 2. Sewer and water development impact fees were last reviewed and updated in May 2004.
- 3. The current budget contains an appropriation of \$25,000 to review and update sewer and water development impact fees.
- 4. On May 2, 2006, the Council awarded a contract to Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson to prepare the update.
- 5. The draft report is complete and ready for Council review and consideration.

Analysis & Conclusion:

Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson prepared the original fee study in 2002. The 2004 update was prepared by Foresight Consulting, a former employee of Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson. Staff recommended that the City engage the services of Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson given experience with working with both firms. The Council awarded the contract to Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson. Draft report is complete and ready for Council and public review.
