SUBJECT: 2007 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program

DATE: August 7, 2007

Needs:

For the City Council to make budget appropriations for projects to be accomplished with the City's allotment of 2007 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

Facts:

1. At its meeting of March 8, the City Council adopted Resolution 07-045 determining that the following activities are to be funded with the City's 2007 allotment of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds:

- Following adoption of Resolution 07-045, the City learned that the U.S. Department of Housing and Community Development approved a 2007 allocation of CDBG funds that was \$1,016 less than expected at the time of adoption of Resolution 07-045.
- The City expects to soon be notified that the US Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved the County of San Luis Obispo's 2007 One Year Action Plan, which includes the City's proposal for use of 2007 CDBG funds.
- 4. The City has already budgeted the amount allocated to Administration and Capacity Building (administrative activities), but needs to make appropriations for the non-administrative projects.

Analysis and Conclusion:

Federal regulations provide that no more than 15% of any year's allocation of CDBG funds may be used for public services. The reduction in the 2007 CDBG allocation by \$1,016 necessarily will reduce the amount of funds allocated to public services by \$152. The remaining \$864 (of the \$1,016) could be taken from one or more of the allocations to public

facilities projects. To adjust the allocations approved by Resolution 07-045 to account for the \$1,016 reduction in available 2007 CDBG funds, the following adjustments are suggested:

- Reduce the Therapy Pool Rehab activity by \$864 to \$105,765;
- Reduce the PR Fellowship Development activity by \$152 to \$11,106;
- All other allocations will remain the same.

Policy

Fiscal

Impact: Participation in the federal CDBG Program has involved and will continue to demand a

commitment of staff resources. Utilizing CDBG funds for the allowable administrative

expenses avoids adverse impacts on the City's General Fund.

Options: a. Adopt Resolution 07-XXX to allocate the City's allotment of 2007 CDBG funds.

b. Amend, modify or reject the foregoing option.
