- Airport Safety & Security Mr. Rose reports additional Airport Watch signs have been installed.
 Dialogue continues with Airport tenants to raise awareness and develop a neighborhood watch
 effort. Additional patrols by Police and the Volunteer Police Program need to be requested.
- <u>Visitor Service Quality</u> Mr. Cook provides a written interim progress report. The City's
 Hospitality Department has had dialogue with the FBO to identify goals and expectations of the
 Airport's customer service role. The effort continues.
