The Library Board honored the Library Staff for the Staff's hard work over the past year.

6. **2008 Library Events**

The Library will host author Vicki Leon with a book signing event on Friday January 25th at 7:00 p.m. This event will also honor the Library Benefactor of the Year and is the kick-off of the Library's 100th Birthday Celebration. Julie Dahlen also noted that the Library is currently running a "Can Your Fines" program enabling patrons to pay off overdue fines by bringing non-perishable food items in for the local Food Bank.

7. **January 2008 Art**

The wall and display art will be in honor of Martin Luther King Jr. This will be a joint Recreation/Library venture and will encompass a "Community Gallery" of pictures and writings.
