SUBJECT: Contract Award for City Council Room Audio Video and Control Systems

DATE: November 18, 2008

NEEDS: For City Council to consider awarding a contract to A-Town Media Group to address the City Hall Council Audio Video and Control Systems (AV).

 The existing AV system was installed as part of the 1995 construction of the City/Hall Library complex.

- 2. Many of the system components are non-functional (overhead projector, screen, blinds etc).
- The thirteen (13) year old components are obsolete and cannot be repaired or integrated with today's technology, therefore the system must be replaced rather than repaired.
- 4. Staff worked with a professional firm to design a modern comprehensive replacement AV system and the appropriate bid specifications.
- The City advertised for bids and distributed eight packets interested parties. The City received a single bid of \$109,472.68 (see attached) from A-Town Media Group. Staff has reviewed the bid and concluded the bid received from A-Town Media meets the specifications and is the lowest responsive bid for this work.
- 6 Staff has worked with A-Town Media, to develop a list of four possible options (ranging from a simple replacement of the sound system up the installation of a modern comprehensive system) for Council consideration. These four options are listed in the attached document.

ANALYSIS & CONCLUSION:

Facts:

City Hall/Library Conference Room serves as a meeting place for the City Council, Planning Commission and various groups. The current AV system was installed in 1995 and has undergone several attempted "fixes" over the years as the original components failed. Presently ninety percent (90%) of the system is non-functional. Award of the contract would result in installation of an up-to-date system.

The bid submitted by A-Town Media will effectively meet the needs of Council meetings and other functions held in the Conference room.

A list of four options has been prepared for Council consideration. A-Town Media has indicated its willingness to install any one of the four options presented.

POLICY

FISCAL

IMPACT:

If approved the funds would be allocated from the Facility Repair Fund. The fund currently has an unencumbered balance of approximately \$380,000. However, the General Fund expenditures are forecast to exceed revenue in FY09 by \$797,000. These funds may be needed for other priority repairs (example – ADA warning devices at Amtrak Stop) and/or to cover underfunded general service obligations.

OPTIONS:

- **a.** Adopt Resolution No. 08-xx authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with A-Town Media on one of the options listed below:
 - 1. Replacement of sound system only with ability to transmit to KPRL and record meetings at the cost of \$24,000; or
 - 2. Replacement with system components roughly equivalent to the existing system at the cost of \$50,000; or
 - 3. Replacement and upgrade of key system design components (add 2nd projector and east wall screen) within the Council Chamber at the cost of \$72,000; or
 - 4. Total replacement and upgrade (Council monitors, video streaming, Lobby flat screen TV, & speakers) of the Council Room Audio Video & Control systems at the cost of \$109,472.93.
- **b.** Amend, modify, or reject the above option.
