SUBJECT: Award Contract – Extend Taxiway Alpha at the Paso Robles Municipal Airport
DATE: September 1, 2009

NEEDS: For City Council to consider awarding a contract to extend Taxiway Alpha and related improvements at the Paso Robles Municipal Airport.

FACTS:

1. The Airport Master Plan, adopted by City Council in November 2004, contains provisions to extend Taxiway Alpha as well as associated lighting.
2. In accordance with the Master Plan, the taxiway project was submitted to FAA and received a construction grant.
3. On March 17, 2009, City Council authorized staff to enter into an agreement with Tartaglia Engineering to prepare construction documents to extend Taxiway Alpha and the associated lighting improvements.

ANALYSIS &

CONCLUSION: Bid documents were prepared and advertised, and 11 bids were received at the bid opening on August 6, 2009:

Staff reviewed the low bid submitted by CalPortland Construction and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid. In addition, staff received approval from FAA to proceed with award of the contract.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO EXTEND TAXIWAY ALPHA
AT THE PASO ROBLES MUNICIPAL AIRPORT
(DPW 09-04, AIP 3-06-0184-19)

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Municipal Airport Master Plan, adopted by City Council in November 2004, contains provisions to extend Taxiway Alpha as well as associated lighting; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Master Plan, the taxiway project was submitted to FAA and received a construction grant; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2009, City Council authorized staff to enter into an agreement with Tartaglia Engineering to prepare construction documents to extend Taxiway Alpha and the associated lighting improvements; and

WHEREAS, bid documents were prepared and advertised, and at the bid opening on August 6, 2009 eleven bids were received ranging from \$777,761 to \$1,147,960.09; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the low bid submitted by CalPortland Construction. and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, staff received approval from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to proceed with award of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded almost entirely by Federal and State grants, requiring less than \$700 in City expenditure, to be appropriated via separate action (acceptance of Part B FAA grant funding).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby award a contract to CalPortland Construction in the amount of \$777,761 to extend Taxiway Alpha and related improvements, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
