SUBJECT: Redevelopment Implementation Plan

DATE: December 15, 2009

Needs: For the Redevelopment Agency to consider a five-year Redevelopment Implementation Plan for

the Period 2010 -2014.

1. A public hearing to consider a Redevelopment Implementation Plan is scheduled for the Redevelopment Agency's meeting of December 15, 2009. Public notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with state law.

- State law requires that the Redevelopment Agency adopt an Implementation Plan which shall include objectives for expenditures of regular redevelopment funds (tax increment revenues) and the Low and Moderate Income Housing (LMIH) Funds (20% of all tax increment revenues) and indicate how such expenditures will eliminate blight.
- 3. The current (2004 2009) Implementation Plan was adopted in December 2004. State law prescribes that the 2010 2014 Implementation Plan be adopted by December 31, 2009.
- 4. A Draft Implementation Plan has been prepared, distributed to the Agency. Copies were placed in the Library, and a copy is available on the City's web site.

Analysis and Conclusion:

Facts:

After distribution of the Draft 2010 – 2014 Implementation Plan, the City Attorney advised that additional revisions were needed to address changes in Redevelopment Law that occurred since the current Implementation Plan was adopted.

Additional time is needed to make and confirm the revisions recommended by the City Attorney's Office. The City Attorney has advised that, although state law requires that the 2010 – 2014 Implementation Plan be adopted by December 31, 2009, there are no statutory penalties for failing to do so. It is recommended, therefore, that the public hearing on the 2010 – 2014 Implementation Plan be opened and continued. Prior to continuing the open public hearing to that date, the public should be allowed to add any comments on the matter at the Agency's December 15 meeting.

Options: Upon receipt of public comments, take one of the following actions:

- a. Continue the public hearing for the project to January 19, 2010.
- b. Amend, modify, or reject the foregoing option.
