For City Council to consider accepting an ARRA grant administered by the California NEEDS:

Energy Commission under the EECBG/ARRA Program.

FACTS: 1. The EECBG was developed to administer ARRA funds to small cities and counties.

> By formula (based on population), the City of El Paso de Robles is expected to receive \$156,082.55.

> 3. EECBG/ARRA program funds may be used for cost-effective energy efficiency projects such as lighting retrofits and controls. Projects that identify the highest rate of energy savings will be considered.

The project is estimated to save approximately \$1700 per month in electrical costs.

The City Council is required to adopt the attached resolution in order to apply for this grant. The resolution was drafted by EECBG.

ANALYSIS &

CONCLUSION: Staff has reviewed the EECBG/ARRA guidelines and has determined that a project to

retrofit the decorative light fixtures in the City (300 total) would provide the highest

probability of being accepted to use these funds.

RESOLUTION NO. 09-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES REGARDING A 2009 ENERGY EFFICIENCY CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANT (EECBG)/AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles recognizes that it is in the interest of the regional, state, and national economy to stimulate the economy; create and retain jobs; reduce fossil fuel emissions; and reduce total energy usage and improve energy efficiency within our jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funds are available through the California Energy Commission's EECBG Program for grants to eligible local governments for cost-effective energy efficiency projects; and

WHEREAS, the EECBG Program allows for public agencies or non-profit entities to apply for EECBG funds on behalf of eligible local governments; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles is eligible for EECBG funding under the California Energy Commission's EECBG Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles has considered the application of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) to the approval of the energy efficiency project described in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> In compliance with the CEQA, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby find that the approval of the energy efficiency project described in Exhibit A is exempt under Categorical Exemption Class I because the project is a maintenance project that will not expand existing uses and is limited to only changing light fixtures.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The City Council authorizes the City's Capital Project Engineer, Ditas Esperanza, to submit a collaborative application on its behalf to the California Energy Commission for up to \$156,083 in EECBG funds for the energy efficiency project described in Exhibit A.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> If recommended for funding by the California Energy Commission, the City Council authorizes the City Manager, James L. App, to accept a grant award on its behalf and to enter into all necessary contracts and agreements, and amendments thereto, on its behalf to implement and carry out the project described in Exhibit A.
