Needs:

For the City Council to consider setting a date to interview candidates for the following advisory bodies:

Facts:

- 1. The **Youth Commission** has twelve members with one and two year staggered terms. There are five vacancies; one member is eligible for reappointment.
- The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee has five members with two year staggered terms. There are two vacancies; both members are eligible for reappointment.
- 3. The **Library Board of Trustees** has five members with three year staggered terms. There are two vacancies; both members are eligible for reappointment.
- The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee has nine members with two year staggered terms. There are three vacancies; two members are eligible for reappointment.
- 5. A recruitment notice for the vacancies was placed in local publications and posted on the City's website. The application period ends April 30, 2010.

Conclusion:

In order to have a full complement of members on the City's advisory bodies, it would be helpful for the Council to consider candidates for these committees during May, 2010. There are twelve vacancies; seven members are eligible for reappointment.
