

Challenges

Cuesta Budget Shortfall

- 2009 2010 \$650,000 gap
- 2010 2011 \$1.1 million gap
- 2011 2012 \$2.1 million gap

Accreditation Sanctions

- Fall 2008 Comprehensive visit placed on Warning
- Fall 2009 Off schedule visit placed on Probation
- Strategic Planning
- Title IX Investigation



Milestones

- Opening of the Cultural and Performing Arts Center (CPAC)
- Foundation Endowment Surpasses \$12 million
- Breaking Ground for the North Campus Learning Resources Center (LRC)



The Beginning

- Opened fall 1998
- 105 acres (82 East & 23 West)
- Monumental community and donor effort
- \$4.7 million private gifts
- 1292 students, Fall 1998
- 3 Modular Buildings

- Fall 2010 marks the 13th year of instruction
- 3521 students, Spring 2010
- Fox Family Building –
 Allied Health Math and
 Science completed
 Summer 2005
- Dale J. Schwartz Learning Resources Center under construction
- 6 modular buildings





Educational and Facilities Master Plan 2001-2011

- Student population projected to be at least 5,000 by 2015
 - Spring 2009 end of semester student population = 4,013
- Allied Health, Science and Math Building est. instructional use 2005-2006
 - Achieved Completed in Summer 2005



2001-2011 Master Plan Projections

- Learning Resources Center est. instructional use 2007-2008
 - State approval but previously unable to build due to high construction costs
 - Currently under construction
- Trades and Technology Complex est. instructional use 2007-2008
 - State Approval for funding through June 2013
 - Currently uncertain fiscal climate inadequate building funding bids lapsed



NCC Learning Resources Center

Description

- Significant step in securing Cuesta College as a lasting regional resource
- Two story, 33,385 square foot building immediately adjacent to Fox Building
- Stucco exterior, steel frame construction, clock tower & photovoltaic roof mount
- Open architecture with floor to second story ceiling areas and natural lighting
- Library services area with book stacks, study areas, open computer lab & library lab/classroom



Description

continued

- Large lecture hall with 260 seat capacity
- Six multi-disciplinary classrooms
- Disabled Student Program and Services Office with extended testing room
- Student Success Tutoring Center
- Writing Lab & Math Lab
- Computer Services Office
- Professional Development Center
- Twenty faculty offices

- Early Childhood Education Center
 - Final Project Proposal submitted April 15, 2005
- Humanities Complex
 - Final Project Proposal submitted May 1, 2006
