### DOLLY BADER 100<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY

*WHEREAS, Dolly Bader, an 8<sup>th</sup> generation Californian, has lived 95 years in the Paso Robles area and is now celebrating her 100<sup>th</sup> birthday; and*

*WHEREAS, Dolly Bader is an exemplary and profoundly honorable resident of Paso Robles, donating her time, talent, wisdom, vision, courage, leadership and character to many endeavors locally and nationally; and*

*WHEREAS, Dolly Bader was born October 4, 1910 in Creston and has lived in Paso Robles since 1915; graduating from Paso Robles High School in 1928; and*

*WHEREAS, during World War II Dolly assumed a leadership role in U.S.O. activities, the Red Cross Motor Corps, the Paso Robles Civil Defense, and was a volunteer for the nighttime Plane Watch in the Adelaide hills; ran a poultry business for years in Paso Robles, providing chickens and turkeys for the soldiers at Camp Roberts; and*

*WHEREAS, Dolly Bader has made Paso Robles a better place by being heavily involved with the California Mid State Fair, helping to found it in 1946 and as an active volunteer there since the mid-1950's, serving as supervisor of the floral department since the 1960's and donating more than 150 hours each year; and by being a charter member of the Paso Robles Business and Professional Women's Association and helping to found and organize the El Paso de Robles Area Historical Society in 1985; and*

*WHEREAS, Dolly Bader has applied her passion and dedication to Paso Robles on a regional and national scale by her efforts for and her status as an honorary life member of the PTA and serving on several county educational committees; acting as president during her 10 years with the Camp Fire Organization; helping to found the Los Ninos Chapter Children's Home Society, and holding responsible positions with numerous other boards, service clubs and organizations throughout the years.*
