WHEREAS, law enforcement officers depend upon records and support personnel to provide them with vital services; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau processes all traffic citations, crime reports, arrest reports, traffic collision reports, public records requests, and serves as the central receiving point for all subpoenas and discovery requests; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff entered over 9,000 documents into the Records Management System, processed over 20 subpoenas as court liaison, and provided Live Scan services to 382 citizens; and

WHEREAS, the first personal contact by a citizen at the Paso Robles Police Department is with the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff at the front counter, and they assisted or provided service to approximately 8,500 citizens in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff exhibit compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job; and

WHEREAS, this day has been declared by the California Law Enforcement Association of Records Supervisors (CLEARS), and recognized by Governor Schwarzenegger as Law Enforcement Records and Support Personnel Day.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Duane Picanco, Mayor of the City of El Paso de Robles, speaking on behalf of the entire City Council and the Citizens of Paso Robles, do hereby proclaim November 3, 2010 as LAW ENFORCEMENT RECORDS AND SUPPORT PERSONNEL DAY in the City of Paso Robles, and extend our gratitude to the Paso Robles Police Department Records Bureau staff and support personnel for their dedicated service to our community, their diligence, and their commitment to keeping our City and citizens safe.
