SUBJECT: Sewer Service from TCSD in City Sphere of Influence

DATE: November 16, 2010

NEEDS:

For the City Council to consider a request to enter into an agreement between the City, Cal Fire and the Templeton Community Services District for sewer service within the City's Sphere of Influence.

FACTS:

- In 1998 the City and Templeton Community Services District (TCSD) entered into an
 agreement regarding utility services and boundary definitions. In the vicinity of Ramada
 Drive, TCSD provides water and sewer services to the south side of Volpi-Ysabel Road, and
 developments south. The City will eventually provide services to the north side of VolpiYsabel Road and developments north.
- 2. The southern City Limit along Ramada Drive extends to Calle Propano, about 0.5 miles north of Volpi-Ysabel Road. The parcels between Calle Propano and Volpi-Ysabel along Ramada Drive are within the City's Sphere of Influence.
- General Plan policy precludes the City from providing water and sewer services outside the City.
- 4. The City has received a request from Cal Fire, located at 2510 Ramada Drive to allow the Templeton Community Services District to provide sanitary sewer service to their facility.

ANALYSIS AND

CONCLUSION:

In accordance with General Plan policy, the City does not provide water and sewer services outside City limits prior to annexation. The City however has, received similar requests to allow provision of services by TCSD along Ramada Drive. AJ Contractor Supply directly north of CDF is one such example. The Council accepted their request to allow water service for fire protection. The agreement with AJ and the proposed agreement with Cal Fire are subject to no opposition to future annexation, and connection to City water and/or sewer services when available.

Provision of sewer service by TCSD will not influence future consideration of annexation of this area. The request by Cal Fire does not set a precedent for the city to uniformly consider or allow outside agencies to provide services within the City's Sphere of Influence.

Your timely consideration for this request is appreciated.



WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, OWNER owns certain real property at 2510 Ramada Drive (the "Property") which is located outside the CITY boundaries but within the CITY's current Sphere of Influence, which is more particularly described in EXHIBIT A, on which OWNER maintains a fire station, and

WHEREAS, OWNER is in the process of replacing the existing facility on site, and

WHEREAS, OWNER has been granted permission by CITY to apply to TCSD to provide sewer services, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, TCSD has facilities available to provide the Property with sewer connections; and

WHEREAS, in an agreement dated November 18.1997 CITY and TCSD agreed upon certain service area boundaries for CITY and TCSD, respectively, and

WHEREAS, the Property is within the CITY's service area; and

WHEREAS, OWNER is requesting a connection to the TCSD sewer main near the Property; and

1 962665v2 33444/0001 10/29/2010 WHEREAS, CITY's approval of OWNER'S application to TCSD for sewer connection also is specifically conditioned upon OWNER (1) agreeing not to oppose future annexation to the CITY, and (2) agreeing to connect to CITY sewer services when such services are available within 500 feet of the boundaries of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, execution of this Agreement by OWNER, CITY and TCSD, and subsequent performance by OWNER of its obligations and by its successors in interest will satisfy the requirements imposed as a condition of approval of permission to obtain sewer service from TCSD.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. <u>Incorporation of Recitals</u>. The above recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.
- 2. <u>Annexation to City</u>. **OWNER** agrees that it will not oppose, directly or indirectly, any request or application to have **OWNER's** Property annexed into the **CITY**.
- 3. Future Connection to City Sewer and Water Services. OWNER agrees that, at its sole cost and expense, it shall, within 90 days after receipt of written notification from the CITY's Public Works Director that CITY has determined that providing water and sewer service to the Property is consistent with CITY policy, install sewer and water connections from the Property to the CITY sewer and water systems. CITY agrees that it shall only provide such notification when a CITY sewer main is located 500 feet or less from the Property line and/or when water service becomes available within 500 feet from the Property. At the time of any such connection to the CITY's sewer or water facilities, OWNER agrees to pay all applicable CITY connection fees then in effect or any other reimbursement fees associated with connecting to such CITY services.
- 4. <u>TCSD Sewer Service.</u> A) The parties hereto agree that **OWNER** may obtain sewer services for such Property from **TCSD**, until the earlier to occur of (i) annexation of the Property to **CITY**; or (ii) installation of a sewer service connection from the Property to **CITY's** sewer system. Any agreement between **OWNER** and **TCSD** regarding the provision of such sewer service shall be consistent with the terms of this Agreement. B) TCSD shall accept effluent from owner as allocation against it's contracted capacity with the city of Paso Robles.

- 5. <u>Waiver of Right of Protest.</u> OWNER agrees, on behalf of itself and its successors in interest, that it hereby waives the right to file or present any oral or written protest of or challenge to, directly or indirectly, the annexation of the subject property into the CITY.
- 6. **Agreement Runs with the Land.** This Agreement shall run with the subject property described above and shall be binding upon the **OWNER** and all his assigns and successors in interest.
- 7. <u>Indemnification</u>. The **OWNER**, and its assigns and successors in interest, shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the **CITY** and **TCSD**, their officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, or liability for injury or death to persons whomsoever or damage or loss or destruction of property whatsoever that is occasioned by the performance or attempted performance of the provisions hereof, or in any way arising out of this Agreement, except to the extent that such claims. are caused by the sole and gross negligence or willful conduct of an indemnified party.
- 8. **Effect of Waiver.** Any waiver at any time by any party hereto of its rights with respect to a breach or default, or any other matter arising in connection with this Agreement, shall not be deemed to be a waiver with respect to any other breach, default or matter.
- 9. <u>Notices</u>. Unless otherwise provided, all notices herein required shall be in writing, and delivered in person or sent by United States first class mail, postage prepaid. Notices required to be given shall be addressed as follows:

- 10. Validity of Other Agreements. This Agreement is in addition to, and does not supersede, any other agreement or agreement entered into by and between the parties hereto, except that with regard to the specific subject mater of this Agreement, this document represents the entire and integrated agreement between CITY, OWNER and TCSD and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements either written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument, signed by both CITY, OWNER and TCSD and recorded in accordance with Section 12 of this Agreement.
- 11. <u>Invalidity</u>. If any term, covenant, condition or provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remainder of the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated thereby.
- 12. <u>Agreement to be Recorded</u>. OWNER, TCSD and CITY intend and consent to the recordation of this Agreement in the official records of the County of San Luis Obispo. CITY shall record the Agreement after its full execution.
