NEEDS: For the City Council to select Mayor Pro Tem and Redevelopment officer

positions.

FACTS: 1. The City Council certified the November 2, 2010 General Election results at its December 7, 2010 meeting.

2. The Council's Policies and Procedures state that the appointment of the Mayor Pro Tempore is by majority vote of the Council every two years subsequent to each regularly scheduled general election.

- 3. Historically, after each election the City Council reconsiders its self-selected assignments for Mayor Pro Tem and Redevelopment Agency Chair and Vice Chair positions.
- 4. The Mayor Pro Tem will act as Mayor in the absence of the actual Mayor.
- 5. The Redevelopment Agency Chair will moderate the Redevelopment Agency meetings; the Agency's Vice Chair will act as Agency Chair in the absence of the Agency Chair.

ANALYSIS &

CONCLUSION: This is appropriate timing for the City Council to evaluate their officer

positions and make selection through majority vote as they determine is

best.
