***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED*** that I, Duane Picanco, Mayor of the City of El Paso de Robles, speaking on behalf of the entire City Council and the Citizens of Paso Robles, hereby recognize the Exchange Club of North San Luis Obispo County on the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of their organization.
