WHEREAS, Doctor Jack Sloan also served on numerous community boards and clubs over the past 35 years which include the following: a member of the Paso Robles High School Board of Directors, a member of the San Luis Obispo County School Board of Directors, the founding President of the Paso Robles Swim Club, and a member of the Rotary Club of Paso Robles;
